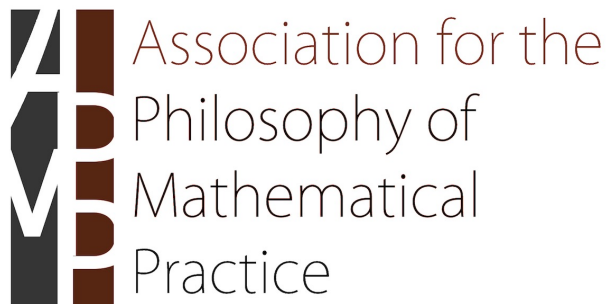

Our 6th international conference was held as an online event 30 June–3 July 2021, with around 200 registered participants. The conference had four plenary talks given by Dirk Schlimm (McGill University), Laura Crosilla (Oslo University), Andrew Granville (Université de Montréal), and Orna Harari (Tel Aviv University). 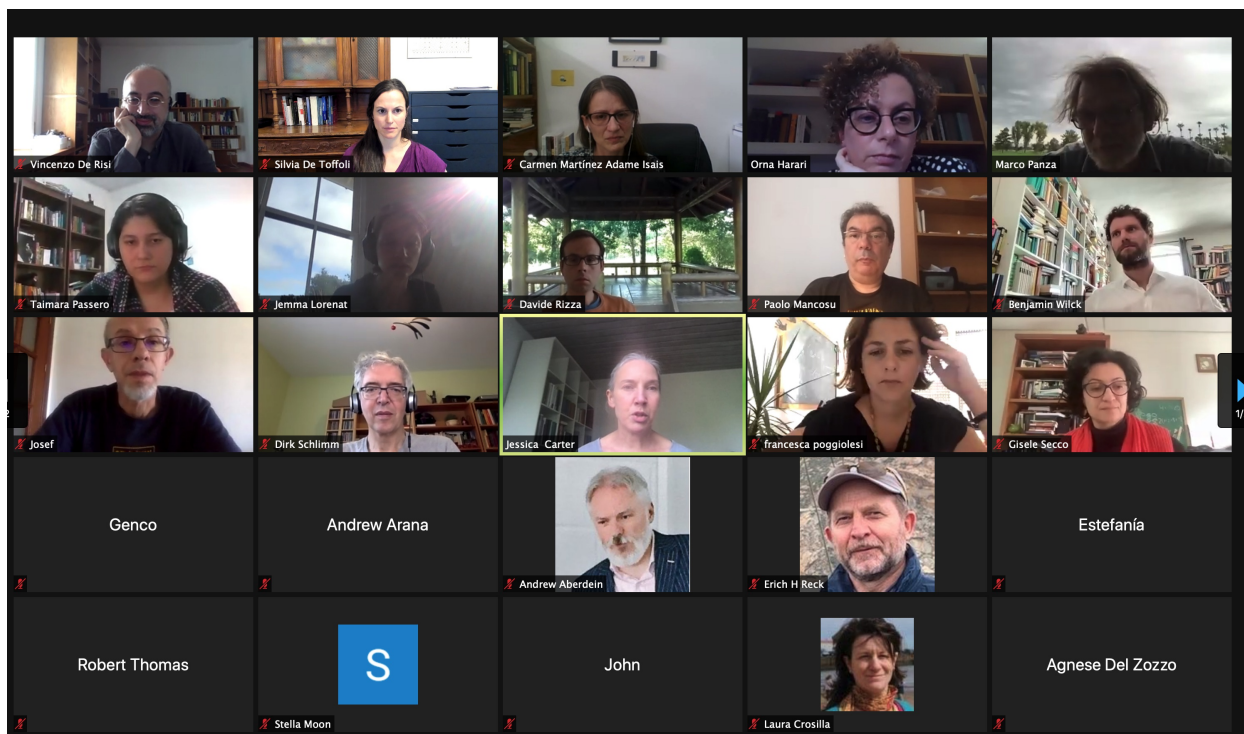
## Upcoming conferences

- Paolo Mancosu (UC Berkeley) is the recipient of a 2020 Chaire d'Excellence Internationale Blaise Pascal. The title of his project is "Infinity: historical, philosophical, and mathematical perspectives". During the academic year 2021–2022 he will be affiliated with the IHPST (Université Paris I, Panthéon-Sorbonne, CNRS) in Paris. In spring 2021–2022, he will organize a seminar with invited speakers at SPHERE (Université de Paris, CNRS).
